The Canada Centre for Remote Sensing is the government institution responsible for the reception and applications of Earth observation data in Canada. CCRS produces the Atlas of Canada and maintains the Geodetic reference frame for the country. Dr. D'Iorio holds a B.Sc. in Geophysics from McGill University and a Ph.D. from the University of Ottawa in Geostatistics. Dr. D'Iorio was previously Director of the Terrain Sciences Division at the Geological Survey of Canada and Director of the Applications Division at CCRS. He started his career at CCRS as a visiting scientist in the climate change group. He has held multiple positions within CCRS and was responsible for the development and implementation of the Innovation Acceleration Centre. He has published and presented over 100 papers. Dr. D'Iorio is past President of the Canadian Remote Sensing Society and has been an adjunct professor in the Earth Sciences Department at the University of Ottawa and in the Geography Department of the University of Montreal.
