Prof. Guo Huadong is a professor at the Institute of Remote Sensing Applications, Chinese Academy of Sciences, Deputy Secretary General of CAS, and Director General of the Bureau of International Cooperation, CAS. He has been engaged in remote sensing research since 1977, devoting to research on radar remote sensing, new earth observing system, and remote sensing for mineral exploration. He was project leader of more than 10 key programs related to earth observation. For the past 10 years and at present, he was and is one of the principal investigators for SIR-C/X-SAR, JERS-1 SAR, ERS-1/2 SAR, Radarsat, Envisat, SRTM, and ALOS programs. He is a member of International SAR Working Group, Chairman of the Associate on Environment Remote Sensing of China, Secretary General of International Society on Digital Earth, guest professor of 7 universities, and Codata executive committee member. He was the Principal Scientist of Expert Group for Information Acquisition and Processing Technology, National High-tech Research and Development Program. For his scientific research achievements, he is the recipient of 3 awards given by the State Ministry of Science and Technology, 9 awards by the Chinese Academy of Sciences or other Provincial agencies. He was entitled “Outstanding expert who has made significant contribution” by the Chinese Academy of Sciences and the State Council in 1992 and 1996 respectively. He has made significant contribution in promoting the development of earth observation technology and applications in China, and enhancing international cooperation programs.
