His research interests have been in the fields of geography and environment, including remote sensing and GIS for natural resources and urban environments, flood disaster evaluation information systems, biomass estimation, and monitoring of coastal environment and global change. He is the author of “Exploring the Geosciences” (6 volume) (1992-2003) and “Geo-information Science and Digital Earth”(2004) . He has received many awards, such as Prizes of National Natural Science Award in China, the First Class Medal of International Eurasia Academy of Sciences (1999), the American Geographical Society’s OM Miller Cartographic Medal (1998) and the Asian Contribution Medal in Remote Sensing (2001).
