Dr. Campbell holds a Ph.D. in Stratigraphy and Sedimentology from the University of Manitoba. Before retiring as Manager of Program Development at the Canada Centre for Remote Sensing (CCRS) in 1998, he was a research Scientist with the Geological Survey of Canada, and held several other management positions in the Department of Energy, Mines and Resources (now Natural Resources Canada).

While with CCRS, Fred developed and managed remote sensing research, training and technology transfer programs in Asia, Latin America, Africa, and the Middle East. The most extensive of these was the GlobeSAR Project - an airborne radar data collection and research program - that was carried out in ten countries around the world. Lasting three years, and involving a large number of investigators in these countries, it was primarily designed to enable users to prepare for the availability of RADARSAT data. A similar program was carried out afterwards using RADARSAT data in nine countries in Latin America, and it had the same goals and objectives.

During this time, Fred worked in, or with, remote sensing and other experts from: Argentina, Bangladesh, Bolivia, Brazil, Cambodia, Chile, China, Colombia, Costa Rica, Ecuador, Honduras, India, Indonesia, Israel, Jordan, Kenya, Korea, Kuwait, Laos, Malaysia, Mongolia, Morocco, Nepal, Pakistan, Papua-New Guinea, Panama, Peru, the Philippines, Taiwan, Tanzania, Thailand, Tunisia, Uganda, Uruguay, Venezuela and Vietnam.

Since his retirement, Fred has been a Consultant on remote sensing projects in several countries in Latin America and Asia for the Canadian Government and Private Companies.
